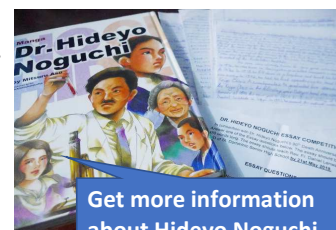
Cadet Corps Competition
